Report of the Month: ABFM Performance Improvement Activity Report

Learn how Dr. Jim Blanding uses the PI Activity report to track his activities and earn continuous certification credit for performance improvement (PI) activities.

Dr. Blanding is a board-certified family physician with the American Board of Family Medicine (ABFM). He started participating in PRIME Registry in 2016, shortly after it was launched by the ABFM. He runs a small private practice, so he uses the PRIME Registry to streamline his practice management, his CMS reporting, and to stay current with the PI Activity part of his ABFM certification.

He just received an email reminding him to complete a PI Activity soon. The great thing is, he's already been tracking quality data for performance improvement activities with PRIME Registry. He uses the ABFM PI Activity report in his PRIME dashboard to output data on which activities are in progress or completed.

To access the report, Dr. Blanding logs in to the PRIME Quality dashboard, and navigates to the report module by selecting the Report icon in the left hand navigation pane. From there, he selects the ABFM Performance Improvement Activity Report.

Then he selects the filters icon, which opens the window (shown at left) where he sets the report parameters.

He selects the current date so that the report will be available in minutes. He can then use this report to choose which activity would be the best option to use for his PI Activity credit.

Note that this report is only for ABFM PI Activity reporting, and cannot be used for CMS program reporting.
